Nuestro Mundo, Inc. (NMI) is the organization that holds the charter school contract with the MMSD Board of Education. NMI is comprised of various members from the community that work to support the school in an effort to carry out the mission of the school.

Location

Housed within Frank Allis Elementary, Nuestro Mundo creates a successful and unique learning environment through the use of dual language education and democratic decision-making. Class Size

Our kindergarten and first grade classes average 15-19 students. Our second and third grade classes average 20-25 students. The classroom sizes will be similar for grades 4 and 5. Our current enrollment is 147.
